School Organisation for Week 1

Monday 12th July - School Development Day - all staff working from home participating in online professional learning & zoom meetings - no student supervision will be provided

Tuesday 13th July - Friday 16th July – the school is open ONLY to students & families who need it - minimal staff supervision will be provided. One unit of learning will be provided to students whether they be at school or working from home.

Learning from Home

Teachers will share a morning video each day via Class Dojo. The focus for work for these four days is revision and practice of prior literacy and numeracy learning.

3-6 - Teachers will post work for the week on Google Classroom. They will not be engaging with students on Google Classroom throughout the day but will be available to parents via Class Dojo if necessary.
