What are we learning about in Term 1?

ENGLISH

This term Stage 1 will be exploring a range of themes such as adventure, multiculturalism, and refugees. Students will be learning about how authors use language to shape meaning for a range of purposes. They will use this knowledge to construct their own texts.

MATHS

In Maths, there will be a strong focus on whole number skills. This involves working with place value to develop proficiency with number. Later in the term, students will undertake a STEM project that integrates art into their maths lessons.

SCIENCE

Students will study the topic 'Living World' and will examine the features of living things, their environment, and how they grow and reproduce. Students will investigate how plants and animals are used to satisfy our needs for food and fibre.

CREATIVE ARTS

Stage 1 will work on a unit of work based on 'Waste as Art'. They will look at the lifecycle of products and the sustainable use of resources when creating artworks. We will be producing artworks using recyclable materials utilising creative and critical thinking skills.

PDHPE

Students will learn about a range of protective strategies and how these can be applied in different situations. They will explore how to build and maintain caring, respectful and inclusive relationships. Students will also be participating in a variety of fundamental movement activities on a rotational basis with our Stage 1 teachers.
