What are we learning about in Term 1?

ENGLISH

This term Year 5 will be exploring a literature unit 'Belonging'. We will be reading a range of short stories and comparing and contrasting the concept of belonging is represented. There will be an emphasis on visual literacy and developing vocabulary knowledge when exploring relationships with others, places, objects and animals.

MATHS

In mathematics, there will be a strong focus on student understanding of whole number concepts and mental computation. Our goal is to for students to develop a solid foundation of number awareness and skills before branching out to other areas of mathematics.

HSIE

Students will study the significance of people, groups, places and events in the development of the Australian colonies and Australia as a nation. We will be exploring the different experiences of people living in the Australian colonies. Students will also investigate change and continuity in Australian society and describe the causes and effects of this change.

CREATIVE ARTS

This term students will be exploring how to draw portraits. We will be studying the famous artist Pablo Picasso and learning about the techniques and abstract style used in his artworks. Students will use a range of mediums to create and draw a variety of portraits.

PDHPE

In Personal Development and Health students will learn about inclusiveness, how to care for themselves and each other and how to build and maintain caring, respectful and inclusive relationships. In Sport and PE students will develop running, dodging, catching, throwing and striking skills with a focus on the sports basketball and T-Ball.
