


Getting ready for school tips

- being comfortable to separate from parents



Opal Cards

Students will need to tap on and off the bus when getting on and off the bus in the morning and afternoon.

No child will be refused travel Replacement school Opal cards are at a cost of \$10

Lost Property

Please have all items labelled with your child's name so if found can be returned to the Red Bus office

Misses their bus stop

It is a suggestion that your child knows their home address or has a contact phone number with them so that the driver can contact the office with the information to try and contact parents or family members. Until connected with their parents, it is best for the child to stay with the driver until the bus returns to the warehouse where you can collect your child.

Application forms are online, every child from K-2 receives free travel even if they are within walking distance.

From Year 3, if you live inside the radius of the school, you will need to apply on safety grounds and until approved you will need to purchase a (green) child opal card. If you live outside the radius, you will be able to continue to use the school opal card.
